On February 8th, 2014 the flags at Edmonton City Hall were lowered to fly at half-mast for former City Councillor Sherry McKibben. Sherry was highly esteemed as a social worker, community activist, and politician. After earning her Masters degree in Social Work and Social Administration at UBC and the London School of Economics she served as Executive Director of the Boyle McCauley Health Centre, Norwood Community Services Centre, and HIV Edmonton. Sherry wrote the book *Daunting Tasks; Dedicated People: Stories in the Management of Change in HIV/AIDS Organizations* while on a Muttart Fellowship. She was a candidate, party president, and Chief of Staff for the Alberta NDP.

Sherry's volunteer work included HIV work in Suriname and Ghana, counselling at the Pride Centre, serving on numerous boards and committees including the Health Sciences Association of Alberta (HSAA), and writing for and delivering her beloved Boyle McCauley News door to door in the inner city. At the time of her death she was working on a proposal for LBGTTQ Seniors housing, a project that is now well underway. She was a two time recipient of the Alberta College of Social Workers (ACSW) John Hutton Memorial Award for Social Action, and of the 2005 Alberta Centennial Medal, among many other accolades.

Sherry touched many lives and shaped her community with her passion for social justice. The funds raised from this tournament will serve to keep her legacy alive and thriving.
